Fellowship: EPA, Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education (ORISE)

A research opportunity is currently available at the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Office of Research and Development (ORD), Center for Environmental Measurement & Modeling (CEMM), Watershed & Ecosystem Characterization Division (WECD) located in Cincinnati, Ohio.

This research project is to conduct analysis of economic impacts of contaminated sites, brownfields remediation and revitalization. The successful candidate will analyze economic benefit surrounding community might realize from contaminated site remediation, restoration and revitalization efforts using non-market valuation methods (revealed preference approaches such as hedonic pricing). In addition, other economic impacts may also be analyzed such as impacts on employment, income, poverty and local tax revenues.
