Liberal Education: Some requirements may be satisfied by taking courses as part of the major, but others will need to be satisfied by taking additional course work as part of the 120 credits needed to graduate.

^[1] *Diversified Core Curriculum:* Students take 4 credits in *physical science* (including a 1 credit lab), 4 cr. in *biological science* (including a 1 cr. Lab), 3 credits in *historical perspective*, 3 credits in *arts and humanities*, 3 credits in *literature*. (Note: 3 credits in *mathematical thinking* are met by taking MATH 1142 or 1271.)

^[2] *Designated Themes:* Students take 9 credits from any 3 of the 4 remaining themes). The themes are: *Civic Life & Ethics, Diversity & Social Justice, Environment, and Technology & Society*. Note: *Global Perspectives* is met by taking APEC 1101.

^[3] *Writing Intensive:* Students need to complete 1 or 2 first-year writing courses and 4 writing intensive courses. Two of the writing intensive courses must be taken at the upper division level, one of which must be taken in the student's major. By taking WRIT 3562W, MGMT 3033W, and APEC 4821W you complete this requirement.

Carlson School of Management (CSOM):

^[4] The CSOM core includes: ACCT 3001, MGMT 3001, and MKTG 3001. You take 1 of these courses. In addition you choose either a set of CSOM elective courses or a CSOM minor. The minimum CSOM elective requirement is 6 credits. If you take a minor in CSOM, the minimum will be 12-16 credits depending on the minor you select.
