Agricultural & Food Business Management Minor

This minor is designed for undergraduate students who want to include courses in business management (such as marketing, finance, entrepreneurship) to enhance and/or supplement courses in their major program and prepare for careers in industry or a graduate business program. The minor has a microeconomic, firm and industry-level focus.

No more than 6 credits may be counted toward both the major and minor degrees. Students must complete Principles of Microeconomics plus three elective courses at the 3-000 level or higher. A minimum GPA of 2.00 is required for minor program coursework overall. All courses are to be taken on a letter grade basis with a minimum grade of C- in each course.
